KLEIN, Daniel, le jeune

fl. France 1745–47

Son of Daniel l'aîné (Gdańsk 1672–1744); he seems to have been the author of three oil paintings of the dauphines to judge by the ages of the sitters. The attribution of an anonymous pastel (of which there are numerous versions) thought to be of the duchesse de Penthièvre suggested by J.-J. Petit seems reasonable stylistically, if currently unverifiable; however the identification of the sitter remains confused: she bears a strong resemblance to the first dauphine, whose portrait by Klein was engraved by Wille, and appears to derive from an anonymous full-length oil in the Royal Castle in Warsaw.
