KLINGSTEDT, Karl Gustav

Riga 1657 – Paris 1734

Miniaturist and enamelist, specialising in galant scenes. He was active in Paris from 1677 where he was known as Clinchetet (he appears as such in a poem by Voltaire dedicated to the duchesse de Bouillon; also Clinchetel, Clyngstel etc.). There is no evidence that he worked in pastel, but a “dessin” from the Dumont sale of 1793 catalogued as by Clinchetel appears to be the pastel by Glain from the Jullienne sale. One assumes this is a simple confusion.
