KRAUS, Jan

Poland c.1760–p.1808

Kraus settled in Warsaw in 1794; his origins are uncertain. He became a supporter of the Kościusko uprising. After its suppression he went to Galicia and is said to have made pastel portraits, among them some of the Baworowski family. A still life from 1800 is known.
