KORDENBUSCH von Buschenau und Thumenberg, Georg Friedrich

Beringersdorf 15.VIII.1731 – Nürnberg 3.IV.1802
Physician, scientist, astronomer, writer, amateur
miniaturist and pastellist. He received a broad
scientific training in Altdorf, later travelling to
Strasbourg, Mainz, Bonn, Köln, Amsterdam,
Haarlem, Leiden and Utrecht, settling in
Nürnberg where he practised as a physician. In
1769 he was appointed director of the
observatory founded by Eimmart (*v.* Maria Clara
Eimmart).
