LANGLOIS, Jérôme

Paris 1753–1824

Miniaturist. The son of a scrap merchant, he enrolled with Vien at the Académie from 1770 to 1776. He was third medallist at the Académie royale in 1780, and exhibited in the salons from 1793. The only known pastel (or coloured chalk drawing) is of his friend Buzot. He also made miniatures of Buzot and his friend, Mme Roland. Langlois's son Jérôme-Martin (1779–1838) was also a portraitist.
