## **LIMBORGH, Hendrik van**

The Hague 1681–1759

History painter, portraitist and engraver; pupil of Brandon. The Louvre monochrome pastel, by “Limborg” and assigned to Hendrik van Limborgh in various catalogues, seems to belong to an earlier period. It may be by Michiel van Limborgh (c.1620–p.1675), a portraitist belonging to the guild of painters in Middelburg in 1647. Spellings Limborg, Limborch, Limburg etc. are also found.
