Peintre de l'Académie de Saint-Luc; portraitist. It is unclear if he was the author of the pastel of his widow listed in his posthumous inventory, nor is there any other evidence that he worked in pastel. At his death the minor children were Anne Agnès (22), Pierre (17), Louis-Marie (16) and Claude-François (13), while an elder brother, Paul Louvier was already a maître peintre; several other painters were among the amis listed in the registres de tutelles.
