LAGLAIRE, Pierre

fl. Toulouse 1768–78

Pierre Laglaire or Laglere, originally from Marmande, a pupil of the Académie de Toulouse; exhibited ink drawings, portraits and a history piece at the Académie de Toulouse between 1768 and 1778. By 1778 he was at the head of the École gratuite de dessin at Bayonne. The first exhibition included his copy of an unspecified portrait by Perronneau. There is no evidence that he used pastel.

On 30.I.1771, Pierre Laglaire married his fellow student Vitale Fauré (*q.v.*) in Toulouse, 30.I.1771; the contract was signed in the boutique de M^e Sans, notaire, by the chevalier de Mondran.
