## MARIA CHRISTINE Erzherzogin von Österreich

Vienna 1742–1798


Several members of Maria Theresia's family were active as amateur artists (*v.q.* Marie-Antoinette). Mimi's gouache drawing after a Troost print at Schönbrunn is erroneously described as a pastel in some sources. She may be the "archiduchesse Marie" who paid 450 florins for 4 months' lessons with Pierre-Joseph Lion (*q.v.*) during his stay in Vienna 1760–68.
