Pistoia 10.V.1754 - Venice 1831

Genre painter and portraitist based in Venice; he produced oil paintings, drawings, engravings and at least one pastel which may be early nineteenth century. He was employed by the Garagnin family of Croatia, and may be responsible for a pastel copy of Isabella Marini after Vigée Le Brun tentatively attribued to Gian Luca de Garignan (*q.v.*).
