MIETZSCH, Christian Gottlieb

Dresden 1742–1799

Also Mietsch. History painter and portraitist in oil and pastel; draughtsman and engraver. He studied under Silvestre and Hutin. His Crucifixion, exhibited in Dresden in 1767 (when the author was described as an “Unterlehrer”), was praised for its “geistreiche Zusammensetzung”, as were several free drawings by the same hand.
