Rotterdam 21.IV.1740–28.II.1808

Genre painter, draughtsman and engraver, working in Rotterdam and, in 1763, The Hague. Taught by his father and Aert Schouman. A number of oil conversation pieces are known, as well as some portrait drawings in chalk.
