## **MOOSBRUGGER, Wendelin**

Rehmen, Vorarlberg 20.X.1760 – Aarau  
20.VIII.1849

Austrian portraitist in oil, miniature and occasionally pastel. He was a pupil at the Mannheim Akademie, later recorded in Karlsruhe, Vienna, Konstanz (1794) and Stuttgart before settling in Switzerland. His sons Friedrich and Joseph were active painters in the nineteenth century.
