NUMAN, Hermanus

Ezinge 1744 – Amsterdam 9.III.1820

Dutch painter of stage decorations, landscapes, portraits in oil and pastel; engraver and draughtsman. He was a pupil of Jan Augustini (*q.v.*) in Haarlem, was recorded in Groningen, worked with Le Bas in Paris 1768–69, and then settled in Amsterdam where he became director of the Felix Meritis society.
