Endingen 1745 – Phalsbourg 1804

Also Oelenhainz, Oehlenhainz. Portraitist in oils, taught initially by his uncle Wolf Dietrich Majer and by Wilhelm Beyer at Ludwigsburg before he travelled to Vienna and enrolled at the Akademie, of which he became a member in 1789. He worked in Stuttgart, Zurich, Basel, Bern, Karlsruhe and Paris. Only one pastel is recorded.
