Ghent 8.III.1737–15.I.1820

A member of the guild of painters in The Hague in 1763, he travelled to England and exhibited crayon portraits at the Society of Artists in 1766 (from Mr Arreste's, Warwick Street, Golden Square) and 1767 (from Mr Miller's, Glasshouse Street, Burlington Gardens), and was at Norwich in 1767–68. He is represented by an oil self-portrait in the musée des Beaux-Arts, Gent.
