PEALE, St George

?St Paul, Maryland 1745 – Baltimore 1778

Brother and pupil of Charles Willson Peale (*q.v.*), referred to as an amateur portraitist in crayons (letter by C. W. Peale to West of 20.IV.1771). He was active in Annapolis copying his brother's portraits, and is shown holding a crayon in the Peale family portrait (New-York Historical Society). He was Register of the Maryland Land Office from 1777.
