## **PERREGAUX, Jeanne-Marie-Françoise, Mme Ferrier**

Lausanne 20.x.1777–10.v.1838

Marie Ferrier-Perregaux was the daughter of Jean-Alexandre Perregaux (1749–1805), an architect and ivory carver from Vallangin, Cormondreche, and Catherine Maisonnay; she was baptised Marie-Françoise in the reformed church in Lausanne nine days after her birth, with her paternal grandparents as parrain and marraine. In 1804 she married Jean-Samuel Ferrier (1777–1812). Known mainly as a miniaturist, she also painted in pastel according to the letters of Sophie de Laroche.
