PIATTOLI, Giuseppe

Florence 1743–1823

Son of Gaetano Piattoli and his wife, née Anna Bacherini (*qq.v.*); painter, draughtsman and engraver; professor of drawing at the Accademia in Florence. He may well have taught Anna Tonelli (*q.v.*) as they collaborated on a portrait of the family of Granduca Pietro Leopoldo engraved in 1785.
