PETITOT, Joseph

Heuilly-sur-Saône 28.VIII.1771 – Belley
20.VII.1844

Petitot (who was not directly related to the enamellist) trained with Devosge in Dijon. By 1789 he had moved to Geneva, where he advertised in the *Feuille d'avis* as a pastel portraitist and offered drawing lessons.

Le Sr Petitot, arrivé depuis peu de tems, peint le portrait en pastel: ceux ou celles qui désireroient se faire peindre n'auront qu'à s'adresser à mad. Marion, tenant boutique au mouton rue des Boulangers, qui indiquera sa demeure: il se flatte de satisfaire le désir des personnes qui voudront bien l'honorer de leur confiance.

Some inconclusive evidence suggests that he was in Paris during the early 1790s; a passport dated 1800 seems to mark his definitive relocation from Geneva to his native Burgundy, where he worked at Bourg in 1800 and then at Mâcon and Belley (Nantua). Genevois subjects continue in his known work in the early nineteenth century, indicating frequent trips.

Petitot's art was of modest ambition. His subjects belong to the petit-bourgeoisie, and all look at the viewer in rather stiff poses. There is a Protestant sobriety allied to these repetitive, occasionally wooden compositions. But at his best – one may cite the portrait of Sestié and the 1814 Vieillard – Petitot executed these pastels with acute observation and minute technique. This is found also in the one known extraordinary still life. It is difficult not to feel the weight of Liotard's achievement hanging over Petitot, but impossible to agree with Baud-Bovy that beside his portraits “pâlissent et se figent la plupart des portraits de Liotard”.


