### PIGULSKI, Józef Mateusz

Warsaw 1724 – Königsberg 1817

Also Pichulski, Pigulsky, Pikulski. He spent many years in the service of the bishop of Warmia (Ermland), Adam Stanislaw Grabowski, and records survive showing payments for religious paintings and altarpieces between 1747 and 1757. By 1761 he had moved to Königsberg; parish records for the Old Town include the baptism of his daughter in that year. In 1765 his name appears in the register of Universität Königsberg as "elegantioris picturae cultur". He is mentioned briefly by Bernoulli as a pastellist in 1775 and by Podbielski in a letter to Chodowiecki (28.VI.1779) as a copyist in oils, and as a painter of wretched pastel portraits "ohne Zeichnung und Ähnlichkeit". From 1801 he resumed the life of an itinerant portraitist. He was recorded in Berlin (c.1789) and Vilnius (1798, where he advertised as a pastel portraitist, residing in the Pac Palace). He also worked for the court of Stanislaw August, according to accounts showing payments in 1781, as well as for Andrzej Zamoyski.
