PINHAS, Salomon

Bayreuth 1759 – Kassel 1837

German miniaturist and draughtsman; Hofminiaturmaler in Kassel from 1788; son of Juda Löw Pinhas, a portraitist in gouache at the court in Bayreuth. Two pastels from 1808 (Israel Jacobson and his wife) are in the Israel Museum, Jerusalem; it is unclear if Pinhas worked in pastel before 1800.
