POLTZ, Daniel Ernst

Dresden c.1720–1774

Painter of portraits, religious and mythological works, from Dresden active in Warsaw from 1749. He was mentioned in archives as a court painter in 1739, 1748, 1754, 1760 and 1773, working for the king and major aristocratic families such as the Czartoryski, Potocki and Lubomirski. In 1752 he worked for Branicki alongside Marteau. According to Rudzińska he made some sketches in pastel.
