RAMDOHR, Friedrich Wilhelm Basilius von

Drübber 1757 – Naples 1822

German lawyer, diplomat and amateur art historian; he also practised as a portraitist in oil and pastel. After studying at Göttingen, he was based in Dresden. In 1806 he was appointed Prussian minister to Rome and Naples.
