RAWLINSON, Richard

London 3.I.1690–6.IV.1755

Antiquary, topographer, bishop, benefactor of the University of Oxford, collector and amateur pastellist. The three portraits mentioned by Nichols were bequeathed to the Society of Antiquaries but later revoked. His brother Thomas was also an avid book collector. Their father was Lord Mayor of London.
