RICHARDSON, Jonathan, Sr

London 1667–1745

Pupil of Riley; founding member of Kneller's academy in 1711. A fashionable portraitist in oils and prolific draughtsman, mainly in small-scale plumbago or in larger blue sheets with black chalk. Many of these finished portrait drawings were dispersed in his son's sale on 5.II.1772. Few if any were in pastel; Walpole's attribution to him of a weak copy after Kneller's portrait of Pope has caused some confusion.
