ROSENHEIM, Johan von

Stockholm 1725–1803

A grandson of the painter David von Krafft, he became an officer in the French, Dutch, Hessian and Swedish services, rising to the rank of colonel before being appointed deputy governor of Västernorrland. He was also an amateur artist and trained as a pastellist by Lundberg; several of his pastels have been thought to be by the master. In 1791 he was made an honorary member of the Stockholm Konstakademien.
