ROSENBERG, Johann Georg

Berlin 1739–1808

German printmaker and painter of military, landscape, architectural and theatrical subjects; portraitist in oils and perhaps pastel, possibly confused with his cousin Johann Carl Wilhelm Rosenberg (*q.v.*). Both seem to have studied with Fechhelm and Bibiena. It is unclear which if either was the “Jean Rosenberg, peintre de Berlin, âgé de 22 ans” enrolled as a pupil at the École de l’Académie royale in Paris in .x.1765 (so born in 1743) under the protection of Wille.
