SAINT-AUBIN, Gabriel-Jacques de

Paris 1724–1780

Brother of Augustin. He competed for prizes at the Académie royale between 1750 and 1754 but was never *agrégé*; adjoint à professeur at the Académie de Saint-Luc, rue de Beauvais (1775), rue des Prouvaires (1780); listed in the *Almanach des peintres*, 1776 “rue des Mathurins, hôtel de Cluny”; exhibited 1774. Saint-Aubin was a prolific draughtsman who occasionally employed pastel to heighten chalk drawings. There are however few if any pastel portraits in the conventional sense. His illustrations of catalogues of the Salons and other contemporary exhibitions and sales are invaluable sources for the historian of eighteenth century art.
