SHMOLL, Georg Friedrich

Ludwigsburg c.1745 – Urdorf 1785

Draughtsman, miniaturist and engraver. He accompanied his brother-in-law Lavater on his travels, and provided numerous illustrations for his *Physiognomie*. He is also known for several drawings of Goethe and his family. The “pastels” listed, which have not been seen, appear to include monochrome works, drawings in coloured chalk and possibly watercolour.
