STEVENSON, John and Hamilton

fl. Charleston 1774

John & Hamilton Stevenson, Limners, advertised in the *South Carolina Gazette* (12.XII.1774) the opening of a Drawing and Painting Academy, covering every conceivable genre and medium, including Painting from the Life in Crayons. Hamilton had been a private art tutor “in the most distinguished families at Home”. They offered two free places for talented pupils recommended by the churchwardens or the South Carolina Society. By 1780 they were in Jamaica.
