SUBLEYRAS, Pierre

Saint-Gilles du Gard 1699 – Rome 1749

French painter and draughtsman based in Rome from 1728; he married the miniaturist Maria Felice Tibaldi (*q.v.*). Although known for his chalk drawings, the sole record of a pastel seems improbable.
