## **SALKELD**

*fl.* London 1780–89

The miniaturist from London (No. 3 Surrey side of Westminster Bridge in a 1788 advertisement) offered, in addition to miniatures, portraits in “Crayons, the Sizes 18 inches by 15 inches together, fram’d and glaz’d, at Two Guineas and Half each” according to an advertisement in the *Stamford Mercury*, 26.IX.1782. Foskett has him also in Manchester (Mr Lord’s Spring Gardens, Market Street, *Manchester Mercury*, 14.XI.1780) and Reading (29.VI.1789).
