SORIN, François

Troyes 1655–1736

Painter of religious subjects, landscapes and portraits; engraver of architectural plates, for chanoine Louis Maillet's edition of the *Figures du temple et du palais de Salomon*, Paris, 1695. According to Mariette, he also produced miniatures and pastels. The pastel recorded as belonging to Grosley is after a self-portrait by the sixteenth century wood sculptor who worked on churches in Troyes.
