SPADA, Leonello

Bologna 1576 – Parma 1622

Italian painter and draughtsman, known as “scimmia del Caravaggio” following a trip to Valletta. He was apprenticed to Cesare Baglioni and later studied with Ludovico Carracci. The “pastel” listed in this early inventory may be a chalk drawing.
