THIBALLIER, Théodore de

f.l. Nancy 1758

The amateur artist who signed this portrait of Stanisław Leszczyński (which is derived from, but is not an exact copy of, the painting by Jean Girardet) may be Claude-Théodore de Thiballier (Triconville 1710 – Favières 1783), chevalier, ancien officier au service de France, who was born and died in Lorraine; in 1739 he married a Jeanne-Claude de Condé. His uncle Charles-Théodore de Thiballier is another possibility; he might be the M. de Thiballier, a member of the garde du corps du roi de Pologne, who died in 1759 having retired to the abbaye de Sainte-Marie Majeure in Pont-à-Mousson.
