TICHBOURN, Mrs Mary

fl. Isleworth 1763–66

Exhibited three pastels at the Society of Artists from 1763 to 1766. She was possibly a member of the family of Catholic recusants correctly spelled Tichborne, possibly the Mary Blount (–1799) of Mapledurham who married Sir Henry Tichborne (1710–1785) in 1742, although he had succeeded to the baronetcy in 1748. Isleworth was a Catholic centre. Lady Tichborne's will exists, but casts no light on her interests.
