TISCHBEIN, Johann Valentin

Haina 11.XII.1715 – Hildburghausen 24.IV.1768
Pupil of Fiedler in Darmstadt 1729–33, of Freese in Kassel c.1736 and then of Lippold in Frankfurt. He was active in Laubach, as Hofmaler from 1741, and later in Maastricht and The Hague. From 1765 he was Hofmaler to the Duke of Sachsen-Hildburghausen. A single pastel bears a signature which may be his or that of Wilhelm Tischbein.
