

TROY, Jean-François de

Paris 1679 – Rome 1752

Painter; pupil at the Académie royale from 1697; *reçu* 1708; professeur 1719; directeur de l'école de Rome. The two drawings in the La Béraudière sale noted by Ratouis de Limay do not seem securely attributed, and the only firm evidence that Jean-François de Troy was a pastellist is based on the study for a painting which is more in the nature of a drawing with pastel than a finished work.
