Gap 13.v.1758–5.i.1833

Initially he followed his father's profession as a goldsmith, but he entered the army during the Revolution, becoming a chef d'escadron in the artillery. He returned to Gap to become *essayer de la garantie*. He was also apparently a skilled pastellist, and his family portraits “ne manquaient pas d'un certain mérite”.
