THIELE, Friedrich Johann Alexander

Dresden 1747–1803

Painter and engraver of landscape subjects; pupil of his father, J. A. Thiele (*q.v.*) with whom some confusion may have arisen. One item exhibited in Dresden in 1769 was described as in pastel; its pendant was probably also a pastel.
