ULFELDT, Gräfin von, née Maria Isabel Prinzessin von Lobkowitz

Prague 1726 – Vienna 1786

“Mme d’Oufelt-Lokowski” paid 484 florins for lessons with Pierre-Joseph Lion (*q.v.*) during his stay in Vienna 1760–68. She was evidently the Lobkowitz princess who married Corfitz Anton Graf von Ulfeldt (the subject of a Liotard portrait) in 1743. Another pupil was “Mlle la comtesse d’Oufelt”, one of her two daughters. As Maria Wilhelmine (1744–1800) had married Franz de Paula Jan Josef Graf von Thun Hohenstein in 1761, the pupil must have been Maria Elizabeth Graf von Waldstein (*q.v.*).
