### VAN DYCK, Sir Anthony

Antwerp 22.III.1599 – London 9.XII.1641  
Anthonie, Anon, Anotoon van Dijck, Van Dyck etc. was not a pastellist, but copies of his paintings were made by numerous named artists (v. Alphen; Dacke; Dysart; Hoin; Luttrell; Pope; Tassaert) as well as by a number of unidentified hands.
