This unrecorded painter died in a single room on an upper floor of a house in the rue du Cimetière-Saint-Nicolas-des-Champs. His heirs were his father Nicolas and his brother, a marchand mercier. His belongings included “huit boîtes à crayons”, as well as 22 pictures, “tant portraits en pastel que crayons”. Presumably these were by the deceased.
