VAUGHAN, Sir Robert Howell

Merioneth 1723 – 1792

Sir Robert, son of the sheriff of Merionethshire, was made 1st baronet of Hengwrt, Nannau and Rug just a year before his death. In 1765 he married Ann Williams, an heiress. As noted by Miles Wynn Cato, the two profiles of his sons are similar to other works by him in gouache, and dissimilar to pastels by Parry to whom they were incorrectly attributed in the 2008 sale
