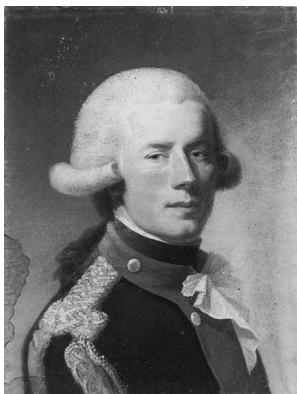


**VELTHUYSEN, Johannes**

Doesburg 1754 – Delft 1843

The scanty information on this artist derives from an inscription on his self-portrait. Velthuisen was a Kapitein in the grenadiers, regiment Oranje-Gelderland. By 1795, when he married Wilhelmina Elisabeth Bopp, he was a town counsellor in Delft; he was subsequently a receiver of direct taxes for Pijnacker. He was an amateur portraitist in pastel and miniature.
