VINCENT, François-Élie

Geneva 1706 – Paris 1790

Painter and miniaturist, established in Paris from 1745; father of F.-A. Vincent (*q.v.*). He was *reçu* peintre-vernisser at the Académie de Saint-Luc in 1756, directeur 1765 (rue Neuve-des-Petits-Champs), adjoint à professeur by 1775.
