WAGNER, Johann Martin von

Würzburg 24.VI.1777 – Rome 8.VIII.1858

History painter and portraitist; he used pastel during his studies at the Vienna Akademie, where he was a pupil of Füger and took first prize in 1802. A pastel traditionally attributed to him was offered at auction in 2015 judiciously catalogued as circle of Füger; its attribution is currently undecidable.
