WELTÉ, Gottlieb

Mainz c.1745 – Revel c.1790

Painter and etcher. He studied initially under his father before moving to Frankfurt, where he painted figures in Schmitz's landscapes. He taught the Estonian painter Helene Zoege von Manteuffel, whose portrait he made. He appears to have supplemented his meagre earnings from art with his musical skills.
