## **WINTERGERST, Anton**

Kempton 1737 – Schrezheim 1805

Innkeeper; he married the daughter of Johann Baptist Bux, owner of the faience factory in Schrezheim which he established in 1752. Wintergerst took over the factory in 1800, and his widow in turn continued the business. He was also a painter, as was their son Josef (1783–1867). When in 1774 Prince Kraft Ernst of Wallerstein was married to Marie Theesia von Thurn und Taxis, Wintergerst was responsible for the nuptial decorations of the town of Wallerstein.
